LETTER FROM THE LEAGUE CHAIRMAN

More improvements await our WGA members this league season. The Waveland management team have updated their public tee time reservation system to include our league tee times. This means that Waveland will be managing league tee times for us ongoing. This will prevent overriding tee times that accidentally occurred in the past. Each WGA member will be configured with a tee-time login account which will be separate from our scoring app

account. More information will on net skins and match play be released as the season start draws near.

An additional change will be made to hole handicaps. For years, our hole handicap (difficulty) was based on the Waveland course scorecard which was based on white tees only. In order to be more fair and equitable, we will have front and back 9 handicap holes that are based on our league average scores-per-hole from last vear. This will have an effect

The annual WGA League Tournament has been scheduled for Sunday, July 31st. The tournament committee will apply the following local rules to 2022 participants:

- The tournament will be pre-flighted
- Current league 9-hole handicaps as of tournament week
- IF 9-hole handicaps have not been established entrant plays as scratch
- Your handicaps will still be applied within your flight
- The low scorers from gross and net will be selected to go to the IGA Team Club Championship
- Flights will be determined by the committee chairs according to number of entrants and handicaps.
- All ties will be determined by card count back.
- Will have a Scratch/Gross Champion
- Will have a Handicap/Net Champion (regardless of flight)
- Will have great payouts with many flights.
- Will be eligible for Hole-in-one progressive jackpot (sitting at \$400 at season start).
- Will still have the same great day

Reasons for Local Rules

- You will be playing against other members with similar handicaps
- Rewards playing your best golf on tournament day
- Eliminates the "luck of the draw" used in previous years
- A golfer with a lower handicap can't have a bad day and win money
- Will form the best team to represent the WGA in the State tournament

2022 USGA Rules will be in effect for the tournament with the exception of playng your ball up in your own fairway. Additional exceptions may be instituted by the committee depending on course conditions at tournament time.

Sign Up for 2022 Match Play!

A \$10 entry fee with your League registration or at the Spring Banquet gets you in. Match play is limited to 64 players. The Match Play Committee pairs the first match at random. Players are expected to promptly arrange their own match times. (Matches do not have to be played on league night!) If you have a problem setting up your match, please call Dave Spiering or Cory Schultes. Their number will be posted on the board bracket sheet. First round matches should be completed by the end of week 3; subsequent matches are expected to be played within two weeks of the prior match. The winner of each match is responsible for posting the win on the Match Play bracket sheet. If matches are not played in a reasonable time, the Match Play Committee will contact both players to get the match played or will declare a forfeit as appropriate.

Your WGA handicap at the time the match is played is used. Players should address questions before play starts and come to agreement, e.g., handicaps, which 9 is to be played, extended play in the event of a tie at the end of a match, etc. All entry fees go back to the top four finishers as prize money.

Editor's Note Match Play 2021 was complete by season's end for the first time in years. Way to go everybody!

Joe Finn was our 2021 champion, with Tom Weaver finishing second, and Ryan Osborn and Thomas Jennings as runners-up.

The Match Play Committee would like to wish all 2022 participants good luck and to look for emails from the League Chairman on reminders and handicap updates for upcoming matches. Let's finish on time 2 years in a row!

The Skins Game

In an ongoing effort to simplify and speed up the check in process on league nights, the Skins games will only be available on a Prepaid for the Season basis. This entry method has worked well the last few of years and allows the WGA to provide some much larger carryover payouts! If you want in for the 18 week season, the online signup option will be your **only** opportunity to get in on the Skins games. One dollar per week for Gross and Net Skins for a grand total of \$36 will give you the chance to get your name posted as a weekly winner on the board. Winnings are paid as clubhouse credit to be used by the end of the calendar year. Be sure your scores are posted via the cellphone software application the WGA now uses and watch your winnings grow on the money list our League Chairman and Website manager provide. Just like the lottery, you can't win if you don't play. It just takes one really good hole or a high handicap to win. Go low!

•ONLINE ENROLLMENT - This newsletter is attached to an email you received inviting you to signup for our league. *Please take advandtage of the variety of signup options which allow the league to provide monetary prizes for you the members.* A new feature of the signup will be if you paid IGA dues through another member course, provide your GHIN number for that course, and the WGA will work with you to reimburse you that portion of the registration fee. Ex: Clubhouse credit/gift card

•SCORECARD SUBMISSION - The phone application for our league is through GolfSoftware.com. Please download it and get with League Chairman Cory Schultes to provide you with a user id and initial password. This phone app scorecard submission vastly reduces the man hours required to manage such a large league if for no other reason than eliminating illegible handwriting.

•PACE of PLAY - The WGA averages over 175 players per league night, so we must play ready golf !!! The pace of play is a common complaint issue received by the board. Please be respectful of others and keep up with the group in front of you. Early and late in the season can be especially challenging for the late tee times to finish before dark. I know it can be difficult for our members still in the workforce, but please be ready to play at your tee time or you may have to be worked in at the starter's discretion, making you one of the late tee times!

• LEGENDS WEEKEND - look for a special email announcement of a new tournament coming to the Wave.

• COURSE IMPROVEMENTS - After years of lobbying, I finally will have a bag stand to place my clubs on while going to check in at the pro shop.

Lastly, I would like to note the passing of longtime league member, Allan Knudsen. I was on the the same team with Al on the infamous, Lawyers and Defendants. The Waveland Golf Association provides marshals on Hole #12 during the Principal Charity Classic, a premier local fund raising event on the Champions Tour. This year the event runs from June 1st through June 5th. Hole captains Joe Finn and Dave Spiering will continue to organize our volunteer effort for 2022. Volunteers are expected to work at least a minimum of two six-hour shifts.

An online registration is required again this year. The volunteer package will be shipped directly to the volunteer. New Cutter and Buck uniforms will require khaki pants or shorts. The fee for this year's volunteer package is \$59.00. The Volunteer Package for 2022 includes the following:

(1) Polo and (1) Hat or Visor (Valued at \$59)
Volunteer/Marshall Badge = FREE admission (Valued at \$35/day)
Designated Volunteer Parking & Shuttle service
Meals, snacks, and beverages on Workdays (Valued at \$15/day)
Volunteer Party (Valued ???, beer and food usually in limited supply)
Two Gallery Good-Any-One-Day tickets for family and friends (Valued at \$70)

This package has an estimated value of between \$235 to \$410 and can be yours for just \$59 dollars. Additional uniform items and tickets may be purchased at time of registration. Jackets from previous years (current logo preferred) may be worn. The application states that because the Classic operates as a 501(c)3, your volunteer fee is tax deductible.

Volunteers park in a designated area at the west side of Southridge Mall. Shuttles will transport volunteers to the entrance. Approximate Shuttle hours are:

The PCC prefers signup be done online at http://principalcharityclassic.com. If you have an ID and pasword from last year, it will not work! You will need to recreate an account to volunteer. The process has you select 3 unique volunteer assignments. Choose Marshals Hole 12, Marshals, and Marshals Hole 11. The last two are irrelevant, but are required to complete the signup process.
