Plus a few dollars more; that's what WGA Members won while having fun and competing in the WGA events during the 1982 season. The 1983 Season promises at least this much, and maybe more, during a full schedule of weekly and holiday events.

Events Chairman Jack Bentley assures that the '83 schedule will include the most popular events from past seasons and that "handicaps" will be the "name of the game." The usual event runs from Monday through Sunday. Unless posted otherwise, the entry fee is \$1 per entry and any individual may enter as many times as they desire, and in any combination, so long as entrants are WGA Members.

It's easy to enter. Ask for the SPECIAL WGA scorecard, and get it date-stamped. Sign up on the WGA Event Sheet, and pay your entry fee.

When you have completed your round, turn in your scorecard at the special box by the cash register. Your card must show your score for each hole (for best ball events, show scores for both players on each hole). DO NOT figure your net score! The Events Committee will do this, using current handicaps. For some events you will be asked to keep count of total putts or other hole scores for the round. The results will be posted for each event on the outside Bulletin Board. REMEMBER! First and Last names must be on the scorecards, appropriately dated and signed, or they will be disqualified!

The handling of the entries, money, and scorecards is a service provided by Frank O'Braza and his Staff at no cost to WGA. For this service, we give a BIG Thanks in behalf of all members.

The '82 Season was a tough one, what with all the rain, but the pattern of using the following Thursday as the routine "rain date" also appears to work quite well. Average attendance topped 90 players per nite, in spite of rain uncertainties.

As in past years, League signups will begin at the Spring Banquet on April 5th, but unlike other years, NO NEW SIGN-UPS will be permitted after May 10th, the Tuesday before League Draft. Your best approach? If you want to play in League, sign up at the Banquet.

Cost of the 14 nite schedule will be the same as last year, \$10, all of which will be returned to players as prize money. The special events on each League nite will be selected by the League Chairman and his assistants. They will not be announced in advance of play, so it is a "must" that you use only the WGA SPECIAL EVENT card and record every item each nite. Come to the Banquet on April 5th and hear all about it. Remember! You don't need to be a "low handicapper" to win! Just LUCKY! Blind Bogeys (or maybe doubles), Blind Partners, Birdies, Eagles, Putts, (High or Low, or even), or any crazy combination can produce \$\$\$ on any League Nite.

The Team scoring format will be determined by the size of the League but will be patterned after past years.

Any WGA Member making a Hole-in-one at Waveland will be honored at the Fall Banquet.


Aces between April 5th and August 28th, with two witnesses, will share in the special \$25.00 prize fund.


HAPPY 32nd, WGA!

The result? W.G.A. Board has opted to try a computerized system which has been presented by another member, Myron Reaman. As our new Handicap Chairman, Myron will explain the new system at the Spring Banquet, so come and get enlightened. It involves posting your own scores on special sheets that will be posted, along with instructions.

Remember, we begin posting 18 hole scores on Saturday, April 9th, and the first official new handicaps will be available prior to the first League nite, May 24. All handicaps from 1982 will carry into the new system.

Those members who have not had a handicap must post a minimum of five 18 hole scores to appear. The new posting sheets will show the names of all W.G.A. Members.

1983 CITY TOURNAMENT

The 80th. Des Moines City Amateur Tournament will be held June 3, 4 and 5th. Entry fee is \$15.00. No new sign-ups will be accepted after the first tee-off on Friday morning, June 3rd. Entries will be accepted at Waveland Pro Shop beginning on May 14th.

Each entrant will declare the division, championship or flight, in which they attempt to qualify. The times will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Final rounds will be played on Sunday, June 5th, and tee times will be assigned, based on qualifying scores.

WGA Members, this is our big tournament of the year and we need lots of help! Please, talk to President Watson about assignments or sign up on the sheets that will be posted in the Pro Shop. All of us, including your President, want to play in this tournament but your help is essential! Please find out how rewarding your time can be.

WGA President Harlan Watson asks all Members to get involved in the conduct of all events and activities that are sponsored by the Association. Special help is needed during the City Tournament and Capitol City Best Shot. League nights and other activities also need many "hands." Please do your "bit" and make it easy for all of us!

WGA SCRATCH AND HANDICAP TOURNAMENT

These tournaments have been scheduled for Sat. and Sun., July 9th and 10th. One 18 hole round will be played each day and the 36 hole total will be your competitive score. Entry Deadline is Monday, July 4th, at 6:00 p.m.

One entry fee of \$5.00 qualifies you for both events. This does not include green fees or reservation fees. Season tickets will be honored for green fees.

Make up your own foursome. Sign up and pay entry fees at the Pro Show. These rounds may be played at your convenience on both days, so Tee times are your responsibility.

Once again, the Association will add another \$2.00 per entry to increase the prize fund. Trophies will be presented to both Champions at the Fall Awards Banquet. Handicap prizes will be paid to approximately one of every three entrants.

The low Scratch winner will receive \$100.00 in prizes and his entry fee paid to the Tournament of Champions.

CAPITOL CITY BEST SHOT

This WGA-sponsored tournament, like the D.M. City, is open to non-WGA members. The base difference is that there are no regional restrictions.

The entry fee is \$20.00 per two-person team. This fee includes green fee, and Season passes are not honored. Winners are flighted.

APRIL 5th. IS WGA SPRING BANQUET

Waveland Clubhouse will again be the scene for the kick-off of the 1983 Season. The Spring Membership Banquet registration will begin at 6:00 p.m. with Dinner at 7:00. Come prepared to sign up for Association membership. League sign-ups will also be available. Bring a new member.

TEE TIMES ON LEAGUE NIGHTS

Tuesday eves., from 4 to 6 p.m. (during the 14 night League season) are part of the benefit that WGA receives from the DM Park Board. Your WGA Board has agreed to allow every fourth group of non-league golfers to have priority; but if there are no such players present at the tee, the WGA may use that time slot also.
