Cart users please pay special attention to the white marker lines and signs around the greens and in the fairways where they are used to divert cart traffic. All golfers should replace their fairway divots and take care to mend ball marks on the greens - we are always very impressed with the condition of the greens after each day's play when we host the Men's City Tournament, they are as clean of ball marks on those evenings as any time during the year. I guess the better player in general just recognizes these things - and cares about them - it's our golf course and everyone should care. Another thing we want to accomplish is the playing a nine hole round in two hours, and an eighteen hole round in four hours. Larry and his staff will insist on this, since it is necessary to them if they are going to maintain the daily tee time schedules.
